

Flight: \$900-\$1500 (book early!)

• Board: \$600-\$900

Tuition:

Resident \$4,030-\$7,045

Non-Resident \$6,603-\$11,548 (4-7 credits)

Tuition DiscountingResident Example


- Resident Student
- Receives a \$17000(86%) academic yeartuition discount
- Student takes five (5) hours in Lyon
- \$576.04 in tuition
- \$920.83 Fees
- Total = \$1,496.87

Tuition Discounting Nonresident Example

- Nonresident Student
- Receives a \$5000 (25%)
 academic year tuition
 discount
 - 4 credit hours in Lyon
- \$2468.75 Tuition
- \$2573.33 Nonresident Fee
- \$738.67 Additional Fees
- Total = \$5,780.75

Employment


- Summer in Lyon Scheduled to Allow Clerkships




