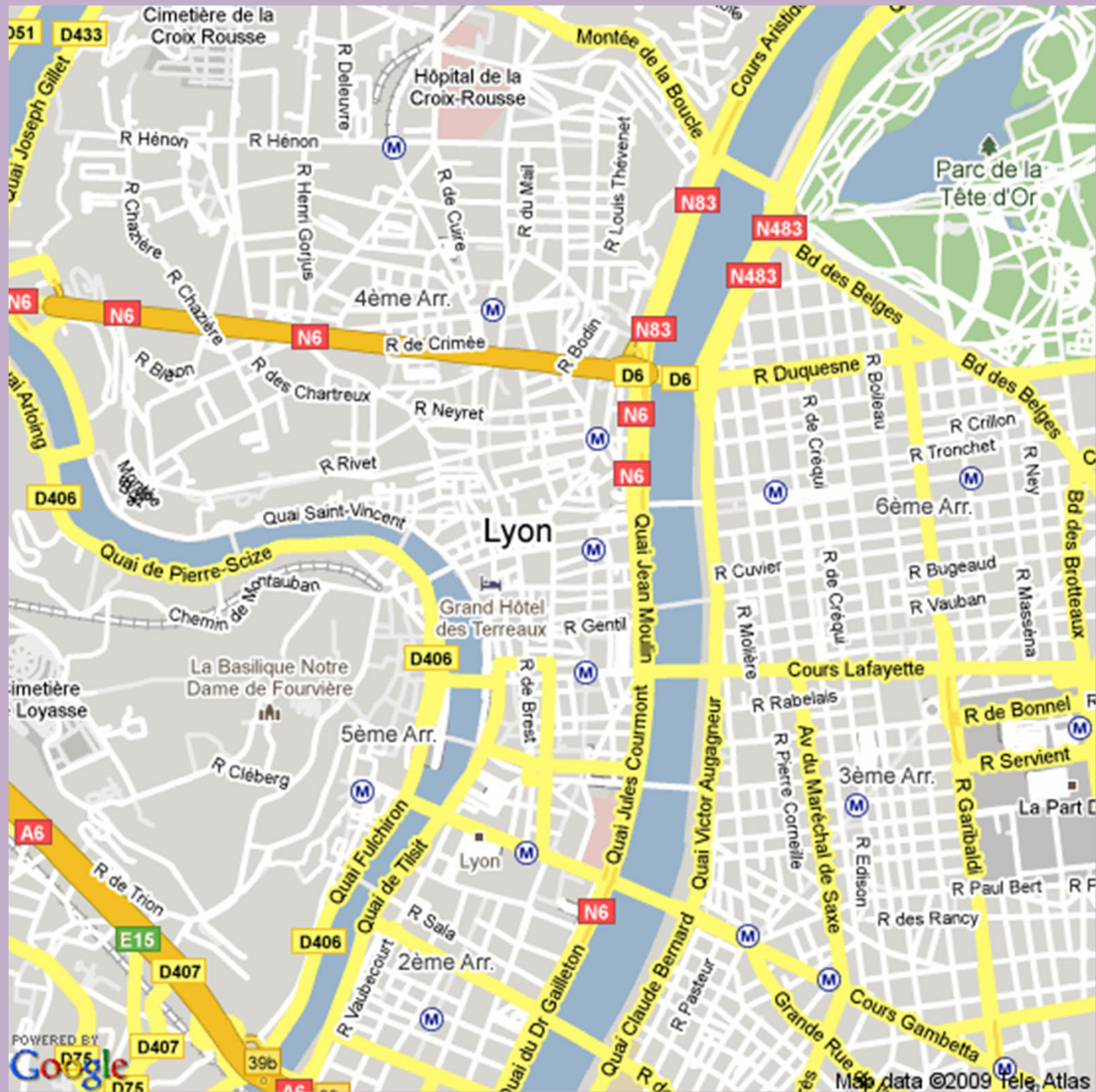

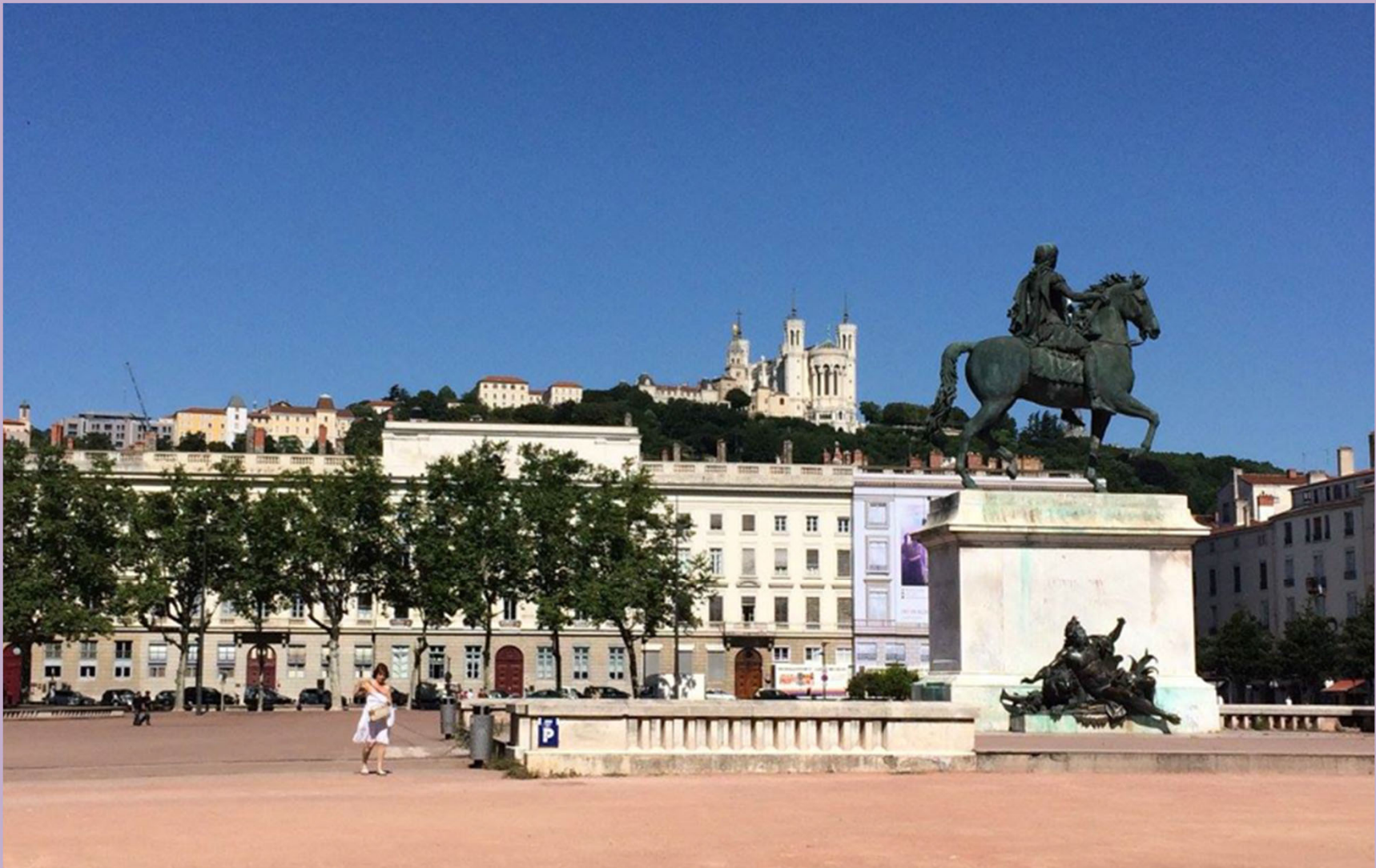

# Budget Estimates



- Flight: \$900-\$1500 (book early!)
- Board: \$600-\$900
- Tuition:
  - Resident \$4,030-\$7,045
  - Non-Resident \$6,603-\$11,548 (4-7 credits)
- Food:
- Travel: budget varies, \$1,000 - \$10,000
  - Ex. flight to Barcelona \$100, drive to Cannes \$30, rent a sailboat \$95, train to Interlaken \$35, hostel in Pamplona \$180, airBNB in Paris \$139, flight to Prague \$200, etc., Eurail passes \$300-400

## Tuition Discounting- Resident Example

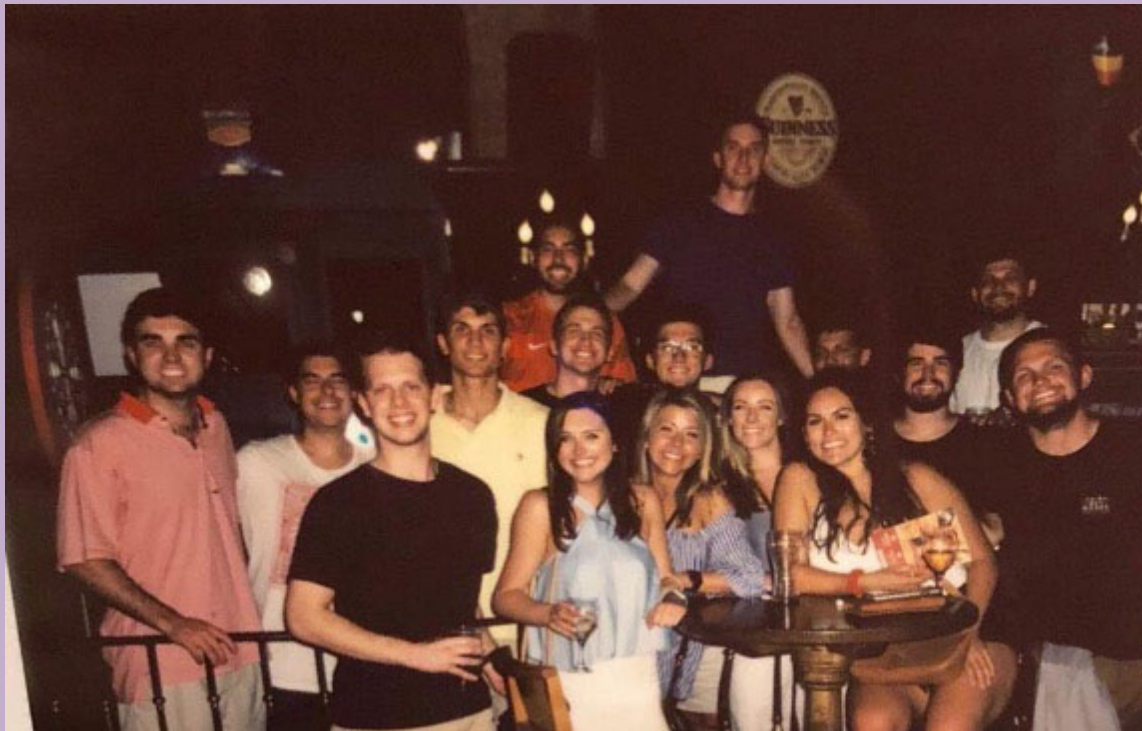
- Resident Student
  - *Receives a \$17000 (86%) academic year tuition discount*
  - *Student takes five (5) hours in Lyon*
- \$576.04 in tuition
- \$920.83 Fees
- **Total = \$1,496.87**

## Tuition Discounting- Nonresident Example

- Nonresident Student
  - *Receives a \$5000 (25%) academic year tuition discount*
  - *4 credit hours in Lyon*
- \$2468.75 Tuition
- \$2573.33 Nonresident Fee
- \$738.67 Additional Fees
- **Total = \$5,780.75**

# Employment

- Summer in Lyon Scheduled to Allow Clerkships
- Roughly One-Half of Last Class Clerked
- Many Baton Rouge Firms Schedule Summer Clerkships to Accommodate Summer in France

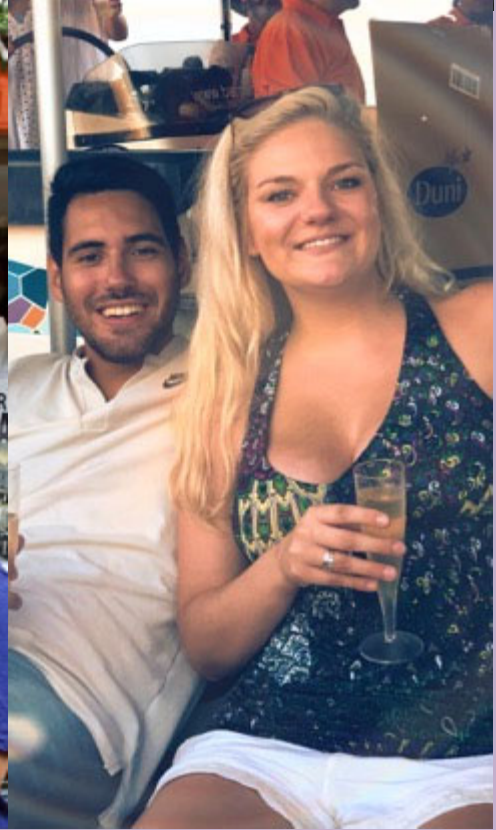

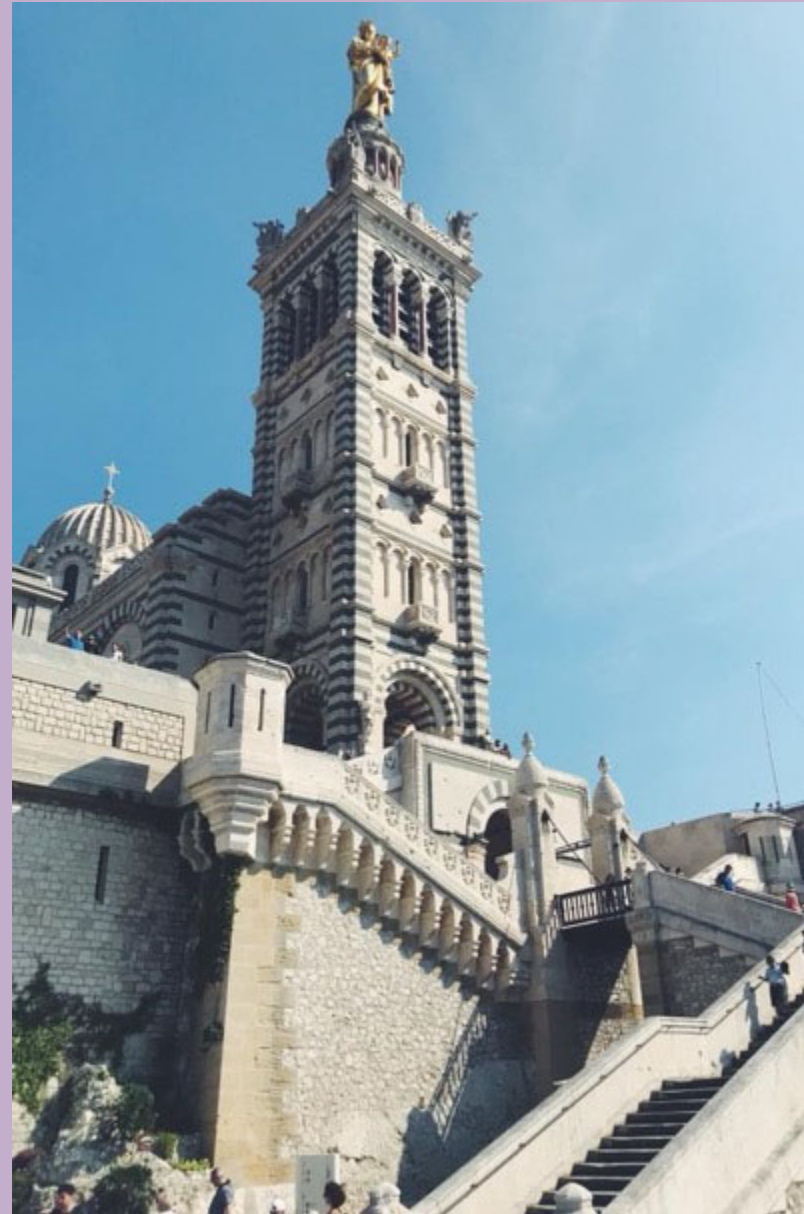

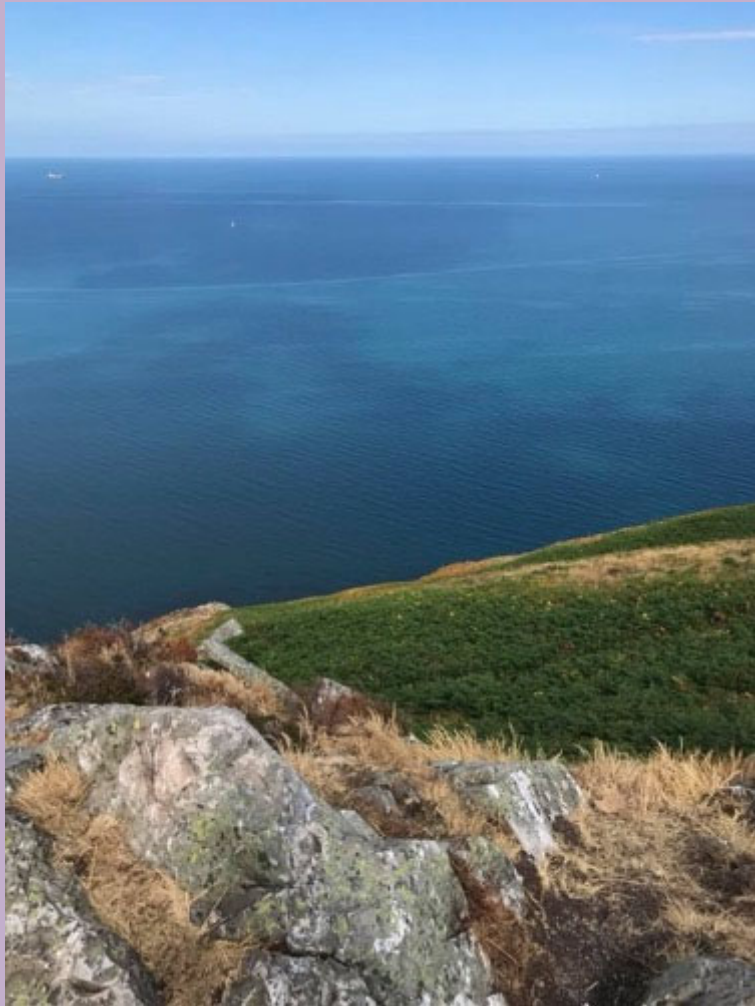
