

# THE ACCESS TO JUSTICE DEVELOPING LEADERSHIP INTERN

The ATJ Developing Leadership Internship is a prestigious full-time, paid internship for first-year law students and a unique opportunity in which participants will gain the insight and skills necessary to become the next generation of access to justice leaders. One student from LSU Paul M. Hebert Law Center will be selected and paired with a sponsoring organization.

The ATJ Internship is a wonderful way for a first-year law student to learn about the organizations that support legal services to the poor, while building lasting professional relationships with lawyers in public interest work and in private practice. Previous ATJ interns have gone on to clerk for state and federal court judges, work with area law firms, and work with other local and national civil legal aid organizations!

The intern from LSU will be sponsored by the Butler Snow and will work with the Baton Rouge Bar Association's Pro Bono Program, the Justice and Accountability Center, Louisiana Applesced, Southeast Louisiana Legal Services, and The Parole Project.

- Rotate through various area civil legal aid offices, courts, and other justice organizations to learn how each contributes to increasing the quality of life for the low-income and vulnerable people.
- Build relationships with civil legal aid organizations, law firms, and bar association leaders and learn how these organizations address the unmet civil legal needs of Louisiana's indigent.
- Work on an access to justice related project, in conjunction with the sponsoring organization, and learn how lawyers in private practice contribute to helping the indigent through pro bono work and other public service activities.
- Meet state trial court judges who are actively involved in developing and supporting pro bono efforts throughout Louisiana.

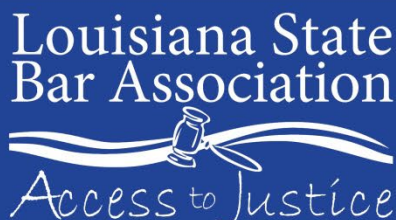
